








The Prostate

- The prostate is a walnut-sized gland located between the bladder and base of the penis, just in front of the rectum
- It surrounds the urethra, the outlet from the bladder, and secretes the fluid portion of semen
- Just as the glandular tissue in the breast can become cancerous, so can glandular tissue in the prostate



Optimizing Resilience Probability Factor (RPF) – A Balancing Act

- Resilience is defined as the process of adapting well in the face of adversity, trauma, tragedy, threats or significant sources of stress — such as family and relationship problems, serious health problems, or workplace and financial stressors
- **Probability** is the branch of mathematics concerning numerical descriptions of how likely an event is to occur. **Probability** is a number between 0 and 1, where, roughly speaking, 0 indicates impossibility and 1 indicates certainty
- The goal is to have a "descent" lifestyle to optimize RPF to be as close to 1 as possible to prevent prostate cancer and any types of cancer


