CERTIFICATION PROGRAM PURPOSES, MEANS & REQUIREMENTS

PURPOSES:

- To gain a greater insight into the basic philosophy to encourage a person's growth in self-awareness: recognizing the equality of all humanity and introducing into society an application of "Love thy Neighbor."
- To ensure that all Certified Practitioners consistently maintain and represent the simplicity and exactness of the BIO-TOUCH points and technique.
- To help participants feel more confident in their ability to share BIO-TOUCH in their communities.
- To provide a basis for volunteer opportunities through IFBM programs and activities.

MEANS:

1. Classroom (or online workbook) presentations and discussions, which include active participation by all class members.
2. Reading and speaking the points as described in the manual.
3. Practicing the sets of points.
4. Learning to creatively apply enhancements using the BIO-TOUCH system.

REQUIREMENTS:

1. Completion of the Practitioner Training, or the Introductory Workshop Correspondence Course.
2. Completion of 12 Certification Classes to consist of:
 - a) One hour, or the equivalent, of Instructor-led classroom (or workbook) discussions on topics as approved by the Accredited Teachers.
 - b) Supervised hands-on practice of sets of points and possible enhancements to address specific conditions
3. Payment of the appropriate class fee which includes:
 - a) A one year Membership in the Foundation
 - b) All printed and educational materials handed out during class, as approved by the Accredited Teachers.
4. Sixty hours of supervised hands-on practice (or 100 hours of unsupervised practice) of the sets of points and application of the *Just Touch* philosophy.
5. Accept, by signature, the Certified Practitioner Agreement.
6. Agreement is to be signed by the proper Foundation representative, and the appropriate certificate issued.
7. If a participant completes the Certification Classes, but does not complete the 60 hours of hands-on practice, they shall be recognized as a Graduate Practitioner and receive the appropriate Certificate.
