As we continue to explore the subject of presenting Bio-Touch, we want to focus on a few additional points.

1. You are a global representative of the International Foundation of Bio-Magnetics (IFBM) and of Bio-Touch. You exemplify the golden rule of “Love Thy Neighbor.” Therefore, to maintain the integrity of Bio-Touch it is imperative that you present it as taught in the manual.
2. Bio-Touch™ and Just Touch™ are trademarked names and are legally protected as identifications and distinguishing terms which sets them apart from other healing techniques.
3. As a Certified Practitioner, you will be able to use all Foundation materials and logos. However, all publicity needs to be approved by the Foundation, as it is a safeguard against trademark violation and personal philosophy infringement.

The Foundation has created programs that allow each Certified Practitioner to pursue their own unique expression in teaching the technique with clarity and integrity. Each of these have a different protocol and timeline for you to follow. This link will introduce you to the different Educational Programs. In Class 11, we will go over the DETAILS of each Educational Program.

❖ **Health Condition Workshop – 2 hour trainings**

This program focuses on a specific health condition. Participants receive workbooks designed with only three or four basic sets of points needed to address a specific condition.

❖ **Introductory Workshop – 4 hour trainings**

The training manual/dvd set in this workshop familiarizes participants with the points and application of the touch. Participants have the opportunity to practice certain sets that do not require removing clothing.

❖ **Practitioner Training – 8 hour trainings**

The Bio-Touch history and IFBM's philosophy is presented in this training. CPs will verbally describe and demonstrate the technique as written in the manual and participants will receive supervised hands on practice of all the points.

Certified Practitioners must request authorization from the Foundation to teach the Practitioner Training. CP must have taught at least one workshop. Application to teach the Practitioner Training will include three case studies, one of which must be from a student of a workshop. Other case studies may be from recipients.

Uniformity and integrity of the Educational Program is vital as each person shares their own creativity. The Foundation has a support team to assist you in evolving your own teaching practice.

Key elements of the Educational Program are the following:

1) You must teach all the points exactly as described in the manual because this insures integrity and uniformity. Using the manual in the class is the only way to guarantee consistency.

2) You need to keep the technique free of personal philosophies. The manual, again, supplies any needed philosophy or explanations about Bio-Touch.

EXERCISE: Without using your hands, describe the Shoulder Set, to yourself. Do this by speaking the language in the manual.

You will be expected to speak the wording of each set to an instructor via a phone or web conference.
